Over the years, she became more involved. "I fell in love with the place. It was one of the best experiences of my life," Eileen explains about her 18-year career at JF&CS. "It was the longest I've worked anywhere, and I'm still friends with some of the staff from there. I felt a sense of family and people supporting one another; it is not an easy job, especially for the social workers. They extend their support to the far reaches of the Jewish community."

Eileen saw firsthand how JF&CS supports those in need. "I believe that the agency is very important to the community. As a child of Survivors, I was really touched by programs like Café Europa. These programs are very special. Sometimes people are just going through challenges alone, but then people with expertise make them feel like what they are going through is normal."

She became a Monthly Mitzvah Maker and hopes to continue giving for years to come. "Once a year is not enough for me. I contribute what



I can. I've seen how it has helped a lot of people over the years. It needs to continue, and the agency needs the community's support. It is important to get the word out, 'You'd be surprised about what's going on there.' It will always be in my heart, and sharing helps the community see what is going on."
